All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

Faxed entries. Entries may be faxed using PayPal services to the account for PARRKEES@aol.com Add \$4 per entry form. Fax entry to (760) 946-9048. Or, use one of the following entry services. Best in Show/Show Connections (800) 247-7005; Entries on Time (800) 992-8955; MB-F (888) 463-6364; or K-9 Entry Service (800) 234-3043. Don't wait until the last day.

Entry errors, refunds. Entries not on an official AKC entry form are not acceptable and photocopies of the entry form must have the Agreement and Instructions attached. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, whoever may make such errors. Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or entry fee(s) will be made.

Acknowledgement. Acknowledgment of entry will be made with an exhibitor's ticket and Judging Program. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary at (760) 946-9048. Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs must be ready for judging. The club and its show secretary will not be responsible, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

Dogs need to be present at show only at scheduled time of judging. Dogs may leave immediately after they have been judged, unless required for further judging.

Loss or damage. The management will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Do NOT leave any dogs in closed vehicles. The welfare of an exhibitors' child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

Health of dogs. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Note. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

Attention! Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their area.

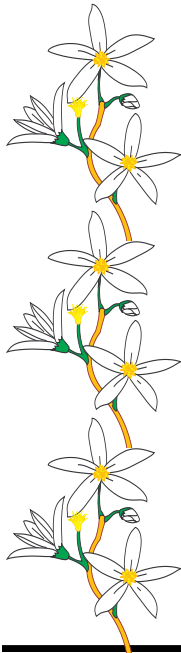

Jr. Showmanship

Novice Class: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

Open Class: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes: Each of the above regular classes are divided by age:

Junior 9 yrs & under 12 yrs on day of show
Intermediate .. 12 yrs old & under 15 yrs on day of show
Senior 15 yrs old & under 18 yrs on day of show

Eligibility of Dog: Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be

substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Show or Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused under the Dog Show Rules for the protection of other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Winning of First Place in an Open Junior Showmanship Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, contact the American Kennel Club, Event Plans, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606-3390. e-mail: juniors@akc.org. At the judge's discretion, the Dachshund Club of America, Inc., Region II, the Dachshund Club of Santa Ana Valley, Inc. and the Dachshund Club of California, Inc. offer Awards of Merit to the quality Dachshunds that are in serious competition for the top awards. It is entirely the judge's decision whether to give all of the available Awards of Merit, some of, or none at all. Awards of Merit are selected from the dogs and bitches in each Best of Variety competition, other than the Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety winners. There will be a special dark green rosette for each Award of Merit.

The number of Awards of Merit available in each variety is determined by the number competing in its BOV competition as follows: 6-8 competing in BOV competition = 1 Award of Merit; 9-12 = 2 Awards of Merit; 13-15 = 3 Awards of Merit & 16 and over = 4 Awards of Merit.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES (FOR ALL THREE VARIETIES)

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the get.

Brood Bitch Class – For Brood Bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the produce.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Variety by virtue of having won in these classes.

Brace Class – For two dogs of the same variety of breed with identical ownership. The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at time of entry and must be entered in a regular class. Team Class – For four dogs of the same variety of breed with identical ownership. The dogs comprising the Team must be named at time of entry and must be entered in a regular or non-regular class. Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. The entry form for a dog entered as part of the Team must be marked accordingly with "Team Class" in the space provided for Additional Class.
