**Make All Checks and Money Orders PAYABLE TO LEA PLAUT, CANADIAN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to cost of processing no refunds of \$5.00 and under will be made. There is a \$4.00 fee for any entry cancellations.

**A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and a Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry, \$3.00 Rally fee** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards**, do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretaries will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** This club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**During the hours of judging** owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready for judging. In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dogs presence is needed in the judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler to bring his dog into the ring.

**The club, its secretaries or their employees** will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds.

**Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Secretaries Office advised at once. The Secretaries and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**Trophies and Prizes** will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of judging, any discrepancies must be reported to the Secretary prior to completion of judging. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

**Dogs which according** to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.

**Junior Handlers** who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest Conformation judging or one half hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

**Please DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dogs are seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision, a California Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Show Committee for disciplinary action. all persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the show giving clubs or their members in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. THIS IS A SELF CLEANING SHOW, PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.

**The show giving club, the show secretary** their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to their dogs or property. And further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

Dachshunds shown in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular form. To enter, write "Sweepstakes" and the age classification in the box for "Additional Class" and add \$12.50 to the regular entry fee.

Sweepstakes classes will be divided by sex in each variety (Longhaired, Smooth and Wirehaired) as follows:

- 6 months & under 9 months
- 9 months and under 12 months
- 12 months and under 18 months

**Sweepstakes Prizes**

The Dachshund Club of Santa Ana Valley will retain 35% of the total entry fees for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows (rounded to the nearest dollar amount):

- 1st Place - 40% of entry fees in each class
- 2nd Place - 30% of entry fees in each class

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

Winners from these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Variety if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show. Note: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible for entry in Veteran, Dual Champion and Field Trial classes, and by virtue of winning the classes, may compete for Best of Variety.

**VETERAN DOGS**

**VETERAN BITCHES**

(For Dogs or Bitches 7 years of age or older)

**DUAL CHAMPION DOGS - DUAL CHAMPION BITCHES:** The Dual Champion class is open to dogs and bitches that have achieved the AKC Conformation and Field Trial Championships.

**FIELD TRIAL DOGS - FIELD TRIAL BITCHES:** The Field Trial class is open to dogs and bitches that have placed in an American Kennel Club member or licensed Field Trial.

**BEST OF VARIETY**

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Variety competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

**AWARDS OF MERIT (in each variety, both days):** At the judge's discretion, the Dachshund Club of Santa Ana Valley offers Awards of Merit (AOM) to quality dachshunds that are in serious competition for the top awards. It is entirely the judge's decision whether to give all of the available AOMs, some of, or none at all. AOMs are selected from the dogs and bitches in each BOV competition, other than BOV and BOS to BOV winners. There will be a special dark green rosette for each AOM. The number of AOMs available in each variety is determined by the number entered in its BOV competition as follows:

- 6 to 8 in BOV competition = 1 AOM
- 9 to 12 in BOV competition = 2 AOMs
- 13 to 15 in BOV competition = 3 AOMs
- 16 and over in BOV competition = 4 AOMs

**AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER CLASS ELIGIBILITY (effective as of 1/1/2009):** The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY:** 1) All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. 2) The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog, and 3) family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in this class.

**SATURDAY ONLY – PARADE OF VETERANS:** This is a non-competitive class open to dogs and bitches over 7 years of age and not entered in any competitive class in the show. Each veteran will be presented with a special rosette with the dog's name printed in gold leaf. **TEAM CLASS:** For four dogs of the same variety of breed with identical ownership. The dogs comprising the Team must be named at time of entry and must be entered in a regular or non-regular class. Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. The entry form for a dog entered as part of the Team must be marked accordingly with "Team Class" in the space provided for Additional Class.

**BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR (All Coats):** SELECTION GUIDELINES. All class winners will be judged at one time at the intervariety level for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor (All Coats)

**BEST OPEN MINIATURE (All Coats):** SELECTION GUIDELINES. All class winners will be judged at one time at the intervariety level for the Best Open Miniature (All Coats)

**BEST FIELD TRIAL (All Coats):** The judge will select the Best Field Trial from the first place winner from the Field Trial dog and bitch classes.
