ENTRY INFORMATION AND SHOW RULES

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE dog(s) will be allowed in the ring.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE ENTRIES received without fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entries fees for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or another acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in obedience or rally trials. No refund of entry will be made for bitches entered in this trial who come into season after the closing date.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed on the show grounds.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE held on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged or when being exercised.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value,

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. For everyone's safety, no baby strollers or wheeled child carriers are allowed on the show grounds.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NO DOG SHALL BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN ANY CLOSED VEHICLE. ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against DCSAV, its members, or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

MOVEUPS: Dogs which according to their owners records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

Heel on Leash (40 points). The orders for this exercise will be "Forward" and "Exercise Finished." Rally signs will be used for this exercise. Signs to be used are "Right turn," "Left turn," "About turn," "Slow," "Normal," "Fast" and "Halt/Sit." A one time single phrase of praise or encouragement, by the handler to the dog, will be allowed without penalty.

Figure 8 (40 points). The orders for this exercise will be called by the judge and will be "Forward," "Halt," and "Exercise Finished." This exercise is to be performed on leash the same as the Figure 8 exercise in Novice Obedience. A one time single phrase of praise or encouragement, by the handler to the dog, will be allowed without penalty.

Sit For Exam (40 points). The principal feature of this exercise is that the dog sits in position before and during the examination without displaying resentment. Orders are, "Sit your dog and leave when you are ready," "Back to your dog" and "Exercise finished." This exercise is to be performed with the dog on a 6 foot leash, and is performed as in Pre-Novice obedience except that the dog remains sitting instead of standing and the judge will touch only the dog's head.

Sit Stay (40 points) – Handler Walk Around the Ring. The principal feature of this exercise is that the dog remains in the sit position. Orders for this exercise are "Sit your dog," "Leave your dog," and "Exercise finished." The handler will stand with the dog sitting in heel position. Prior to starting the exercise the judge will ask if the handler is ready. The leash remains attached to the dog's collar and will be dropped/placed on the ground between the dog and the handler. When the judge gives the order "Sit your dog," the handler will command and/or signal the dog to sit, if they are not already sitting. The judge will order "Leave your dog," the handler will give a command and/or signal to stay and will immediately proceed to walk around the inside

perimeter of the ring in a direction as indicated by the judge. Upon completing a full perimeter walk around the ring, the handler will approach the dog from the front, proceed to walk around and in back of the dog to the heel position. Once the handler has returned to heel position, the judge will give the order "Exercise finished."

Recall (40 points). The principal features of this exercise are that the dog stay where left until called by the handler, and that the dog responds promptly. Orders are, "Leave your dog," "Call your dog," and "Exercise finished." The leash is removed for this exercise and kept by the handler. On order from the judge, the handler may give a command and/or signal to the dog to stay in the sit position. The handler will then walk forward, approximately 25 feet, to a location as directed by the judge and turn to face the dog. On the judge's order or signal, the handler will command and/or signal the dog to come. The dog must come directly, at a brisk trot or gallop, and sit in front near the handler. (No finish will be required of the dog by the handler.) After the judge orders "Exercised finished," the leash is reattached to the dog's collar. A one time single phrase of praise or encouragement while the dog is coming to the handler will be allowed without penalty.

Any dachshund eligible to compete in this trial is eligible for this class.

NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS

These trials will be held indoors in the Orange Empire Kennel Club clubhouse. The ring will take up most of the indoor space so crating will be the cement outside the clubhouse. Exhibitors can setup crating starting at 9:00 am on Saturday morning. DCSAV will provide shelter as needed.

There is plenty of day parking at the clubhouse, but no overnight RV parking. Exhibitors may enter the grounds at 9:00 am on Saturday and at 8:00 am on Sunday.

The Saturday trial will begin early afternoon with obedience judging followed by rally. The Sunday trial will begin in the morning with rally judging followed by obedience.

As of 1/1/2009, dachshunds that measure less than 10" at the withers are eligible for a 4" jump height in both obedience and rally. Please note your jump height on your entry form.
