**CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE ENTRIES** received without fees will not be accepted. **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries. **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS** or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

**ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED** with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

**ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fees for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

**THE CLUB** reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

**ALL TROPHIES** must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the persons showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Breed is over and the Show Secretary's Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the Breed is over.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ~ NEW RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005**

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are assigned by AKC and required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. AKC Junior Handler Number may be obtained by calling the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776

**NOVICE** - This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the times of entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**JUNIOR** - A boy or girl who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show  
**INTERMEDIATE** - A boy or girl who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on day of the show.

**SENIOR** - A boy or girl who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of show.

**OPEN** - This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, who have won 3 first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

**JUNIOR** - A boy or girl who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show  
**INTERMEDIATE** - A boy or girl who are at least 12 years old and under 15 year sold on day of the show.

**SENIOR** - A boy or girl who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of show.

**BEST JUNIOR HANDLER:** A club offering Junior Showmanship may offer a prize for Best Junior Handler, provided there will be competition for this award, a minimum, of two class winners present to compete for the award. The prize is described in the Premium List. Awards of Merit are selected from the dogs and bitches in each Best of Variety competition, other than the Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety winners. There will be a special dark green rosette for each Award of Merit. The number of Awards of Merit available in each variety is determined by the number competing in its BOV competition as follows: 6-8 completing in BOV competition ~ 1 Award of Merit; 9-12 ~ 2 Awards of Merit; 13-15 ~ 3 Awards of Merit , 16 and over ~ 4 Awards of Merit.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR (BBE) CLASS ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES
