after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned and telegraphed entries are not accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

Emailed entries. Entries may be emailed as .pdf attachments using PayPal services to the account for PARRKEES@mac.com Add \$4 per entry form.

Entry errors, refunds. Entries not on an official AKC entry form are not acceptable and photocopies of the entry form must have the Agreement and Instructions attached. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, whoever may make such errors. Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or entry fee(s) will be made.

Acknowledgement. Acknowledgment of entry will be made with an exhibitor's ticket and Judging Program. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary at (760) 946-9048. Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs must be ready for judging. The club and its show secretary will not be responsible, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

Dogs need to be present at show only at scheduled time of judging. Dogs may leave immediately after they have been judged, unless required for further judging.

Loss or damage. The club or show secretary will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Do NOT leave any dogs in closed vehicles. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

Health of dogs. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Note. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

Attention! Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their area.

NOVICE CLASSES: For boys and girls who have not won three first place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

ON DAY OF SHOW:

Novice Junior Class	9-12 years

Note: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made with the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Jr. Showmanship judging. A correction may be made from one age division to another, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any Jr. Showmanship class at the show.

OPEN CLASSES: For boys and girls who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

ON DAY OF SHOW:

Open Junior Class	9-12 years
Open Intermediate Class	12-15 years
Open Senior Class	15-18 years

MASTER CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 year old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Eligibility of Dog: Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience

Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Show or Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Winning of First Place in an Open Junior Showmanship Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, contact the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, P.O. Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051.

The Dual Champion class is open to dogs or bitches that have achieved the AKC Conformation and Field Trial championships. The Field Trial class is open to dogs or bitches that have placed in an American Kennel Club member or licensed Field Trial. Winners from these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Variety if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

Note: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible for entry in Veteran classes at specialties only. Entrants in Dual Champion Dog and Bitch classes and Field Trial Dog and Bitch classes may not be neutered or spayed; they must be intact.

BEST OF VARIETY COMPETITION

AWARDS OF MERIT (FOR ALL THREE VARIETIES)

The Dachshund Club of Santa Ana Valley, Inc. offers Awards of Merit to the quality Dachshunds that are in serious competition for the top awards. Awards of Merit are selected from the dogs and bitches in each Best of Variety competition, excluding the Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety, Select Dog and Select Bitch winners. There will be a special dark green rosette for each Award of Merit. There are two Awards of Merit per Variety offered, regardless of the entry size. They are awarded at the judge's discretion – all, some or none.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES (FOR ALL THREE VARIETIES)

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Variety by virtue of having won in these classes.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the get.

Brood Bitch Class – For Brood Bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the produce.

Brace Class – For two dogs of the same variety of breed with identical ownership. The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at time of entry and must be entered in a regular class. Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. Enter "Brace Class" in the space provided for Additional Class. Each entrant in the Brace class must be intact.

DCSAV Challenge Trophies

Challenge trophies are offered through the Dachshund Club of Santa Ana Valley, Inc., for competition at its specialty shows only and for permanent possession must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. In the case of co-owners, ownership must be identical for all three wins. Ownership is determined by what is printed in the catalog.

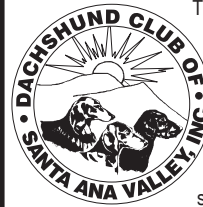
