- **MINUTES:** (Jan Oswald) Minutes from January 22, 2023 were reviewed. Corrections – add meeting date, under sweepstakes nominations 2024 add Marianne Lovejoy. Minutes with corrections were approved.
- **TREASURER'S REPORT:** (Cheryl Shultz) Last balance: \$25,827.41; Income: \$2,246.43; Expense: \$6,662.88. Current balance: \$21,410.96. Expenses were mostly from Invoice from Eileen Parr for 2022 specialties, judges and site fees, new canopies for pop-up tents and table covers.

- Judge nominations and voting for 2024 shows, April 27-28, 2024
 - Judges previously nominated: Johnny Shoemaker, Nicholas Frost, Charlotte Borghardt, Eric Liebes, Jackie Stacy, and Terry Stacy.
Nominations now open: Sherry Snyder nominated Lynn Allen, Sherry Snyder nominated Anne Schmidt, Haley Priest nominated Fred Vogel, Haley Priest nominated Wally Jones. Motion to close nominations by Haley Priest, seconded by Dawn Gordon-Perine. Motion carried. Results of voting: Wally Jones, Fred Vogel. Anne Schmidt as alternate.
- Sweepstakes judge nominations and voting for 2024 shows, April 27-28, 2024
 - Judges previously nominated: Marianne Lovejoy, Maggie Craig, Marlene Groves, Jackie Nolan. Maggie Craig has accepted an assignment for this October, so her name has been dropped from the list. Nominations are now open: Cheryl Shultz nominated Dan Burke, Haley Priest nominated Dawn Gordon-Perine. Dawn declined due to having puppies that she will want to show. Results of voting: Dan Burk, MaryannJ Lovejoy. Alternate is Jackie Nolan.
- Dawn Gordon-Perine:
 - Dawn inquired if the club would be interested in holding a scent work event. There are five levels, but the club can limit to four levels. This is a event generates a lot of income. It's open to all- and mixed breeds. It requires a host club, host coordinator and a volunteer coordinator. Normally 6 to 12 volunteers are necessary. Items also needed are a tent for the scorekeeper and a tent for check in. The club can limit the number of entries, there is a limit of number of entries per judge and what they can judge for the day. Generally, only one trial per year is offered. Dawn knows local judges and can check out locations. Host club would need to provide containers (ex: mailbox, toolbox, shoe box, etc). Buried items are a little more complicated. Judges bring their own supplies and the club pays the judges and scorekeepers. This is an AKC event, dogs are judged on # of hides and timed. There is a qualifier ribbon and there are generally 3 placements per level. Motion by Dawn Gordon-Perine to investigate holding sent work trials for the club with dawn to spearhead the event. Motion seconded by Sherry Snyder. Motion carried.
