At 9 months old, in April, Luna & Otto were awarded placements toward their field championship in Roscoe, Illinois. Then in June in Hortonville, WI, Luna finished her FC. Luna has an exceptional show career as well - she was awarded BOV from the classes several times with & received 2 hound group placements with me showing her & lots of owner handler groups placements including an owner handler reserve best in show. She ended the 2023 show season in the top 40 wirehair dachshunds. Andromeda also had some BOV wins from the classes. Blue & Otto, both finished their championships with some nice wins. In July in Illinois, Norman got a couple placements toward his field championship. Then in October in Wisconsin & Illinois, Otto got enough points to finish his field championship/dual championship. Over the winter, Luna picked up 2 first & a fourth from the field champion class & 2 qualifiers toward the hunting hound title in the pack stake.

We also finished the championship of another pup that was bred by Christine Heitzman. Journey, **CH Incahoots Fantastic Voyage At Grd Mw**. She also has a major towards her grand.

In October in Illinois, **Pearl, GRD's V Moonlight's Spicy Redhead Mw** received a first & 4th placed toward her field championship. She only needs 3 points to finish her FC. She has picked up her Sire & Dam's love for rabbits. She also needs a few points to finish her conformation championship. Pearl is out of Tux, GCH DC GRD'S V MoonLight's Sharp Dressed Man Mw & Valentina, GCH DC MoonLight's Valentine Queen W NE HH.

3 younger pups also got points toward their conformation championship:

-**Shasta, Moonlight's Snows On Mt Shasta At Grd W** finished the summer with 2, 4 point majors

-**And Cruizer, GRD's V Moonlight's World Cruiser Mw** started showing in September & is well on his way to his conformation championship. Cruizer is sired by Chuck & Victor's Wills & his Dam is our Valentina.

-**Macy, Moonlight's Floating Above The Rest W** also has both majors toward her conformation championship. Although we do not own her, her sire is Tux.

**Valentina, GCH DC MoonLight's Valentine Queen W NE HH** was awarded NBQ in a large field champion bitch class in Ladonia, TX & then this winter, she picked up a 2nd & 3rd from the field champion class. In November, she also got 2 qualifiers toward the senior hunting hound title in the pack stake.

**Dax, DC Grd Rebel Against Authority MS** picked up a five point major at the DCSAV specialty in April & then some singles throughout the summer towards his grand.

Last but not least, out of the 3rd litter that Tux sired, we are excited about this line breeding, bred by Ashley Dodd. The pup we kept out of this litter, **Willa Mays, Epiphany & Grd's The Say Hey Kid Mw**, will be starting in the field at the national in April. Her dam is Abs GCH DC Epiphany Holy Cow Mw. Willa Mays is already showing good scenting ability.
